

1. Two Separate Question Papers: We have two separate question papers for the Ph. D. entrance exam. The first paper will be common to all candidates and will cover the topic of research methodology. The second paper will be subject-specific.
2. Randomized Question Order: The questions in both papers are shuffled randomly, ensuring that no two candidates receive the same set of questions in the same order.
3. Exam Duration and Question Count: Each question paper will consist of 50 questions and should be completed within a time frame of 60 minutes. Each question is of 1 Mark. No Negative Marking.
4. No Backward Navigation: To maintain the integrity of the examination, candidates do not have the ability to navigate backward during the test. Once they move forward to the next question, they will not be able to return to previous questions.
