Criteria	Requirement
Paper I – Research Methodology	Maximum Marks: 50
Passing Criteria for Paper I	Minimum 40% marks (20 out of 50)
Paper II – Domain Subject	Maximum Marks: 50
Passing Criteria for Paper II	Minimum 40% marks (20 out of 50)
Total Marks (Paper I + Paper II)	100 Marks
Overall Passing Criteria (General Category)	Minimum 50% aggregate marks (50 out of 100)
Overall Passing Criteria (Reserved Categories)	Minimum 45% aggregate marks (45 out of 100)
NET Qualified Candidates	Eligibility valid for 1 year from the date of result declaration
SET Qualified Candidates	Eligibility valid throughout (lifetime validity)
GATE Qualified Candidates	Eligibility valid for 3 years from the date of result declaration
Professional Courses (CA, CMA, CS, etc.)	Minimum 50% marks required in the qualifying examination
RPET Qualified Candidates (Previous Year)	Eligible to apply for the next 1 year from the date of qualification
Regulatory Authority	Rules based on applicable UGC guidelines and adopted by the University

Important Conditions

1. Candidates must secure **at least 40% marks separately in Paper I and Paper II.**
2. Candidates must also satisfy the **overall aggregate qualifying percentage:**
 - **50% for General Category**
 - **45% for Reserved Categories**
3. Qualification validity for NET, SET, GATE, Professional Courses, and RPET shall be considered as specified above.
4. All eligibility criteria are subject to the latest **UGC regulations and University norms** in force at the time of admission.
