In alignment with the decisions of the Governing Body to impart quality education and appoint faculty for all proposed UG and PG programmes, the University advertised various faculty positions and selected 126 faculty of which 115 faculty have joined the University, while the remaining 11 are likely to join by 1.1.2024, since they are serving a 3-month notice period with their current organisation. The FSR currently stands at 1:20.

Also the University advertised staff positions in July 2023 and 20 non-teaching staff have joined the University in various capacities.

In addition, housekeeping staff (dry & wet, inclusive of gardening), peons and security are appointed on contractual basis.
