Definitions

2. In this Act, unless the context otherwise requires,—
(a) "Adjunct Professor", "Adjunct Associate Professor" or "Adjunct Assistant Professor" means a person from industry, trade, commerce, social, cultural, academic or any other allied fields who is so designated during the period of collaboration or association with the university;
(b) "authorities" means the authorities of the university as specified by Board under this Act;
(c) "Board of Management" means the Board of Management constituted under section 22 of this Act;
(d) "campus" means the area of the university within which

(e) "center of excellence" means the state-of-the-art training or research center established in collaboration with industry or for industry, the industry and society, to provide all types of relevant skills to students in-service employees, working professionals and to undertake joint projects;

(f) "distance and online education" means education imparted by combination of any two or more means of communication, viz. broadcasting, telecasting, correspondence courses, seminars, contact

programs and any other such methodology;

(g) "employee" means any person appointed by the university and includes teachers, officers and other staff of the university;

(h) "fee" means monetary collection made by the university or its colleges, institutions or study centers, as the case may be, from the students by whatever name it may be called, which is not refundable;

(i) "Government" or "State Government" means the Government of Maharashtra ;

under section 21 of this Act;

(k) "higher education" means pursuit of knowledge beyond learning at the stage of higher secondary school education;

(l) "hostel" means a place of residence for the students of

(d) "hostel" means a place of residence for the students of the university, or its institutions and study centers, established or recognized to be as such by the university;

(n) "Official Gazette" means the *Maharashtra Government Gazette*;

(a) "prescribed" means prescribed by Statutes or Ordinances or Regulations, as the case may be, made by or under this Act;

(q) "regulating body" means a body established by the Central Government for laying down norms and conditions for ensuring academic standards of higher education, such as the *University Grants Commission, All India Council of Technical Education*.

Madam/Sir,

Kindly refer to letter No. JSPM/Int/2023/457/Ind/UGC/1 dated 27.04.2023 on the subject cited above. The University has submitted letter of intent of the **JSPM University, Pune Act, 2022 (Maharashtra Act. No. IV of 2023)** wherein **JSPM University, Pune, Got No.719/1 and 719/2, Wagholi, Taluka, Haveli, District Pune, Maharashtra- 4122017** has been established as a State (Private) University, **by the Govt. of Maharashtra**, with effect from **16.01.2023 (Notification No. SFU/2022/C.R.26/Unl-4 dated 16.01.2023)**. Accordingly, the name of the university has been included in the list of universities, as maintained by UGC under Section 2(f) of UGC Act, 1956. The list is available at the UGC website www.ugc.ac.in.

The University may note and adhere to the following:

1. The inclusion of the name of the University in the list of universities maintained by the UGC does not by itself allow the University to make admissions in its programmes. The same may be done only after the receipt of required academic and infrastructural facilities, including library, laboratories and appointment of teaching and supporting staff as per the norms and standards laid down by the UGC and Statutory Council(s) concerned.
2. The University is requested to submit detailed information (soft copy only) in the prescribed format, available at the UGC website at <https://www.ugc.ac.in/ugc/infrastructure/infrastructure-staff> along with supporting documents duly attested by the Registrar of the University within a period of 3 months from the receipt of this letter. The University is also requested to upload the filled in format and appendices on its website by giving a link on the home page so that the information is accessible to the students and general public.
3. After receipt of the information in the above mentioned format, the following procedure would be adopted by the UGC for inspection of the University:

b. In case the University has already started any off campus centre outside the State, it must be closed down immediately. It may also be ensured that any off campus centre which the University shall start will only be per the permission laid down in the UGC (Establishment of and maintenance of programmes in Private Universities) Regulations, 2003 and with the prior approval of UGC.

c. The University shall not have any affiliated Colleges.

d. The University shall not have any branch campus or is not engaged in franchising of higher education even for the purpose of distance education.

e. The University has to follow University Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedures for Award of Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2022, as amended from time to time.

3. No Open and Distance Learning programmes and on-line programmes shall be started without the prior approval of UGC. Relevant UGC Regulations are available on the UGC website www.ugc.ac.in.

4. The University is empowered to award degrees as specified under Section 22 of the UGC Act, 1956 through its campus in regular mode with the approval of Statutory Bodies of the University and Statutory Council(s), concerned. However, universities can award only such degrees as specified by UGC. The University is required to follow the UGC Notification on Specification of Degrees 2014 and its amendment dated 10.07.2014 to award degrees. The specification of degree and its nomenclature of degrees has been specified under Section 22 of the UGC Act, 1956 wherein entry level of each degree and duration of programme have been provided. The approved nomenclature may be followed by the specific area of specialization to be reflected in the degrees. The specification is available on the UGC website www.ugc.ac.in under the link <https://www.ugc.ac.in/gtnews/1061840/specification-of-degrees-july-2014.pdf>.

7. The University is required to follow the UGC (Establishment of and Maintenance of Standards in Private Universities) Regulation, 2003 and other Regulations issued from time to time and posted on UGC website.

a. The information received from the University in the prescribed format would be posted on the UGC website within 10 days of the receipt of the information. Comments would be invited from the general public within 1 month thereafter about the information submitted by the University. The comments received from the general public would be placed before the UGC Expert Committee for perusal.

b. An Expert Committee would be constituted by the UGC, comprising of persons whom the University fulfils the criteria in terms of programmes, faculty, infrastructural facilities, financial viability, etc. as laid down from time to time by the UGC and other concerned statutory bodies such as AICTE, BCI, NMC, DCL, INC, NCTE, PCI, etc.

c. The UGC Expert Committee would inspect the University within 3 months of the receipt of the information for assessment of infrastructure and other facilities available with the University. The report submitted by the UGC Expert Committee would be sent to the University within 2 weeks of the completion of the visit for comments.

d. The University may respond to the report within a period of two weeks after its receipt. The comments received are received from the University within the timeframe, it would be recommended that the University has no comments to offer and further action would be taken on the basis of the recommendations of the UGC. The report and comments received from the University, if any, would be placed before a Standing Committee of the UGC. The recommendations of the Standing Committee would be then placed before the Commission for consideration.

e. The Commission shall take final decision in the matter. It may require the University to submit further compliance report in respect of observations/suggestions of the UGC Expert Committee/ Standing Committee. The compliance report submitted by the University shall be placed before the Commission for consideration.

f. On approval of the Commission, a letter would be issued by the UGC to the effect that the University fulfills the criteria in terms of programmes, faculty, infrastructural facilities, financial viability, etc. as laid down from time to time by the UGC and other concerned statutory bodies.

g. If it is found that the Private University has, even after getting an opportunity to do so, failed to comply with the provisions of the various UGC Regulations including UGC (Establishment of and maintenance of standards in Private Universities) Regulation, 2003 and suggestions given by the UGC Expert Committee, the Commission may pass order to restrict the University from offering any course for the award of a degree and for the post-graduate degree/diploma, as the case may be, till the deficiency is rectified.

h. The UGC may also take necessary action against a University awarding a first degree and /or a post-graduate degree, which are not specified by the UGC and inform the public in general through a public notification.

i. As per the judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case of Prof. Yashpal Vs. State of Chhattisgarh, there is no provision to have Regional Centres/off-campus centres beyond the territorial jurisdiction of the State. In view of the judgement of Hon'ble apex court, the University is requested to adhere to the following:

a. No off-campus centre(s) is opened by the University outside the territorial jurisdiction of the State in view of the judgement of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in case of Prof. Yashpal Vs. State of Chhattisgarh.
