Subject: Special Examination (T1-Retest) for students who were unable to appear for Test-1 Examination conducted during 6-9 February 2026

All the students of FY/SY/TY and Fourth Year (All UG and PG Programs) are hereby informed that the Special Examination (Test-T1 Retest) for students who were unable to appear for Test-T1 (Term II, Even Semester, A. Y. 2025-26) Examination conducted during 06th - 09th February 2026 is scheduled from 17th - 23rd February 2026.

Eligibility: The students who have applied and permitted by the authorities will only be allowed to appear for this examination.

There will not be any further examination conducted for (Test -I) if students fail to appear in this examination.

Students are required to strictly adhere to the following examination norms:

- 1. Reporting Time:** Students must report to the examination centre 30 minutes before the commencement of the examination.
- 2. Dress Code:** All students must be dressed in proper allotted uniform.
- 3. Admit Card (Hall Ticket):** Students must download their respective Admit Cards (valid for Test-1 Feb-2026 only) from their respective "Digii logins" and get it duly signed from respective GFM/Director/Dean and Controller of Examinations to appear for the said examination.
- 4. Identity Card:** Students must carry their original University Identity Card for verification in the examination hall.
- 5. Late Entry Restriction:** No candidate shall be allowed to enter the examination hall 30 minutes after the commencement of the examination under any circumstances
- 6. Attendance Sheet:** Students must sign the attendance sheets regularly; failure to do so will result in non-evaluation of the answer sheet.
- 7. Details on Answer Sheets:** Students must ensure that PRN Number, Course Name and Course Code, Class, students' signature, invigilators signature are correctly written on the answer sheet. Failure to do so will result in awarding zero marks, and the student shall be solely responsible for the consequence.
- 8. Prohibited Items:** Mobile phones (smartphones or basic phones), Smartwatches / Fitness Bands, Earphones, Headphones, Bluetooth Earbuds, Bluetooth Speakers or any Wireless Audio Device, Tablets / iPads, Laptops / Notebooks,

9. Programmable Calculators (Non-programmable calculators allowed only if permitted), Smart Pens / Digital Writing Pads, Portable Media Players, Any other electronic, communication, recording, or storage device etc. are strictly prohibited inside the examination hall/room.
10. **Important Note for Physically Handicapped Candidates (40% or more disability):** Such students who require a writer/scribe must contact the Dean of the respective faculty with relevant documents and a formal request letter, at least 8 days prior to the commencement of the examination.
11. **Answer Sheet Submission:** Students must submit their answer sheets to the invigilator before leaving the examination hall at the end of the session.

All students are advised to follow the above instructions meticulously. Non-compliance may lead to disciplinary action as per university norms.
